The Fund seeks to provide consistent income and capital appreciation by investing primarily in a diversified portfolio of global equities and fixed income securities.


The charts below give a snapshot of the Fund’s investments on June 30, 2017. The Fund’s investments will change.

#### HOW RISKY IS IT?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund’s returns change over time. This is called “volatility.”

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

#### RISK RATING

SPR & Co LP has rated the volatility of this Fund as **low to medium**.

This risk rating is based on how much the Fund’s returns have changed from year to year. It doesn’t tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.


Like most mutual funds, this Fund does not have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

**HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?**

This section tells you how Series F shares of the Fund have performed since inception. Returns are after fund expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund’s returns.

**Year-by-year returns**

This chart shows how Series F shares of the Fund performed in the past calendar year. The range of returns and change from year to year can help you assess how the Fund has been in the past. It does not tell you how the Fund will perform in the future.



**Best and worst 3-month returns**

This table shows the best and worst returns for Series F shares of the Fund in a 3-month period over the past calendar year and to June 30, 2017. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

	Return	3 months ending	If you invested \$1,000 at the beginning of the period
<b>Best return</b>	8.57%	April 30, 2017	Your investment would rise to \$1085.70.
<b>Worst return</b>	-3.51%	March 31, 2016	Your investment would drop to \$964.86.

**Average return**

As at June 30, 2017, a person who invested \$1000.00 in Series F shares of the Fund on its inception would now have \$1090.01. This works out to an annual compound return of 5.56%.

**WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?**

The Fund is suitable for those investors seeking the consistent income and capital appreciation potential of a diversified portfolio of global equities and fixed-income securities and have a low to medium risk tolerance. To recognize a reasonable rate of return, investors should be prepared to invest for longer periods of time. The Fund is suitable for investors seeking a regular target cash distribution.

**A WORD ABOUT TAX**

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live, the type of earnings (i.e., income or capital gains), and whether or not you hold the Fund in a registered plan such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your Fund in a non-registered account, fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series F shares of the Fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

### 1. Sales Charges

There are no sales charges or commissions payable to your representative's firm for Series F shares of the Fund.

### 2. Fund Expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the Fund's returns.

As of December 31, 2016, the Fund's expenses were 1.45% of its value. This equals \$14.50 for every \$1,000 invested.

<b>Annual Rate (as a % of the Fund's value)</b>	
<b>Management expense ratio (MER)</b> This is the total of the Fund's management fee (including the trailing commission) and operating expenses. Some of the Fund's expenses were waived. If they had not been waived, the MER would have been higher.	1.07%
<b>Trading expense ratio (TER)</b> These are the Fund's trading costs.	0.38%
<b>Fund expenses</b>	1.45%

### More about the trailing commission

There is no trailing commission payable to your representative's firm (including discount broker) by SPR & Co LP in respect of Series F shares of the Fund.

### 3. Other Fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch shares of the Fund.

FEE	WHAT YOU PAY
<b>Fee-Based Account</b>	Series F shares of the Fund are only available to investors who have a fee-based account with their representative's firm and whose representative's firm has signed an agreement with SPR & Co LP. You pay a fee to your representative's firm for investment advice and other services.
<b>Switch Fee / Conversion Fee</b>	A fee of 0-2.0% of the value of the shares you wish to switch may be charged by your representative's firm, as negotiated with your representative.
<b>Short-Term Trading Fee</b>	SPR & Co LP may impose a short-term trading fee payable by the shareholder to the Fund of up to 1.5% of the aggregate net asset value of the shares redeemed if such shares are redeemed within 20 days of their date of purchase or switch. For purposes of this short-term trading fee, shares will be considered to be redeemed on a first-in first-out basis. If SPR & Co LP detects excessive trading of the shareholder's shares in the Fund within 90 days of purchasing or switching them, it reserves the right to charge an additional 3.0% of the net asset value of the shares.
<b>Registered Tax Plan Fees</b>	No fee is charged to open, close or administer a registered tax plan administered by SPR & Co LP. However, for other registered tax plans holding other investments in addition to securities of a Sprott mutual fund, an annual trustee fee may apply payable to the administrator of the plan.

## WHAT IF I CHANGE MY MIND?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to

- withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual funds within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities legislation in your province or territory.
